Absentee/Early Voting:

Available as an **option** for voters who do not wish to vote at the polling place on Election Day

- Absentee Voting Period: September 18th through November 2nd
- Ballots for voters who have submitted applications will be mailed **beginning September 18th**. Due to the high volume of requests, allow extra time for the ballot to arrive.
- Ballots can be returned by mail or dropped off at the Auditor-Treasurer's Office.
- In-person absentee voting will also start on September 18th at the Benton County Auditor-Treasurer's Office, 531 Dewey St., Foley, MN Monday through Friday from 8AM to 4:30PM and run through 5PM on November 2nd.
