Scheel amended his motion to include county rd. 21. Keller amended her second. 5 ayes 0 nays, motion carried.
- b. Andrew Wojtanowicz Neighbor concern. Andrew wanted to check if the city had any other ideas of what he could do, he brought pictures. One picture had a storage shed that appears to be to close to the property line. Fandel will check into setbacks in AG.

## 5. DEPARTMENT/COMMITTEE/BOARD/CONTRACTED STAFF REPORTS/UPDATE


